ast week our new gotcha tokens arrived, reigniting the students drive to show respect for self, others and community. The purchasing of gotcha tokens and their collection tubes was instigated as a motion at student parliament where the student body voted in favour of the new system.

Students earn gotchas when they are 'caught' demonstrating respect for self, others and community. The children then place their gotchas in the new classroom tubes and later add them to the larger whole school tubes that are kept in the library. At the end of each term the house with the most
