Voluntary School Contributions

The quality of the education your children receive depends on many factors. The quality of the teachers and the support of the school community are, of course, vital. The quality of the resources and infrastructure are also very important.

To this end, the school is constantly purchasing, updating and John Barwick replacing a vast range of major and minor resources. This might include Library books, electrical equipment, sport equipment, classroom supplies and teacher resources. It also includes work on the equipment, buildings and grounds that help make the school environment both safe and pleasant.

Like all public schools, we ask parents to pay a voluntary contribution towards the cost of educating your child. The School Council has set the figure requested this year at \$80 per child, to a limit of \$200 per family. This amount includes the licence fee for Mathletics, which costs the school in excess of \$3000 a year, and enables students to access the program from home as well as from school.

Thank you so much to the families who have already paid this amount. We have had a good response, but are currently short of expectations. A thermometer (thank you to 6T for the artwork!) has been placed in the school fover to track our progress towards the goal of \$25000. If you haven't yet paid, please help us achieve that goal- remember that it is your child who will be the beneficiary.
