#### Child safety around the school

Once again can I ask all parents dropping their children off at school in the morning and picking them up in the afternoon to exercise extreme care in driving and parking, and to meticulously obey the road rules. Parking in No Stopping zones is dangerous as it obstructs vision of both other motorists, of the Crossing Supervisors and of students and others crossing the road. Crossing unbroken lines and operating the vehicle in any way that is unpredictable to pedestrians is extremely dangerous. The school community would be devastated if there was an injury- or worse- to one of our children, and we all have a part to play in making sure all children are safe.

On a related note, it is also important that we all maintain the rules of good manners and respect when speaking to drivers of cars who are perceived to have broken the rules. The best results in these cases come from education rather than confrontation, and by informing the RTA and Police of any infringements (which we do on a regular basis).


