Special Religious Education at BPS

Berowra Public offers weekly SRE (Scripture) classes as legislated in the Education Act 1990. These classes are taught by representatives of religious groups approved by the department and are held on Wednesdays, from 9.20 - 9.50am. We currently have both Protestant and Roman Catholic classes running and most children are currently enrolled in one of these classes. If at any time you wish to change your child's arrangements for Scripture, please send written notification to Mrs Sheldon (SRE Coordinator.)

Children who do not participate in SRE classes are supervised by a staff member, with meaningful work set by their classroom teacher.

In December 2010 an amendment was made to the Act to allow students who are not attending SRE the option of participating in ethics classes. Ethics classes are provided by Primary Ethics, an organisation established by St James Ethics Centre. Currently ethics classes are only offered to Year 5 and Year 6 students. We have a trained outside provider ready to teach this class in 2012, and children already attending Non-Scripture for Year 5-6 have been advised they may change to Ethics if they wish. Again, if you have any questions regarding this, please contact Mrs Sheldon.
