Mathletics

Berowra Public School uses Mathletics for students from Kindergarten to Year 6. This year, students from Year 1-Year 6 can continue to login and complete Mathletics and Spellodrome activities with the username and password they used last year. Kindergarten students will be issued with their usernames and passwords shortly.

Students are allocated to curriculum courses at the start of each year and can be reallocated throughout the year. The name of each course will not appear on the screen when students login. The courses are based from NSW syllabus/Australian Curriculum and can be altered/designed by class teachers. As a result, students will not see a 'course name', but rather 'topic headings' for their activities.

Please remind students that they can click on the question mark in activities (not tests) to seek additional help if needed.

Students and parents from Years 1-6:

- * Students will be assigned their new courses this week.
- * Students results are kept from previous years.
- * Some activities overlap years.

* 'Gold bars' are earned from completing tests from activities. When students are rolled over to a new course, they do not 'lose' their gold bars. The gold bars relate to the activity, so new activities means new tests and new opportunities to collect gold bars.

Keep our kids safe! Park legally in school zones

No Parking

- Drivers may stop in this zone to drop off or pick up passengers or goods for a maximum of 2 minutes.
- The driver MUST remain in or within 3 metres of the vehicle at all times.
- The vehicle must not be left unattended.
- If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction only applies during the times shown.
- No Parking zones can also be used to drop off and pick up children.

No Stopping

- Stopping is not permitted at any time.
- If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction only applies during the times shown.



Keep our kids safe! Park legally in school zones


Bus Zones

- Drivers are not permitted to stop within a bus zone at any time.
- If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction only applies during the times shown.



Double Parking

- Drivers are not permitted to stop or park between the centre of the road and another vehicle that is parked at the side of the road.
- Double parking decreases visibility for motorists and pedestrians, and significantly reduces road safety around schools.
