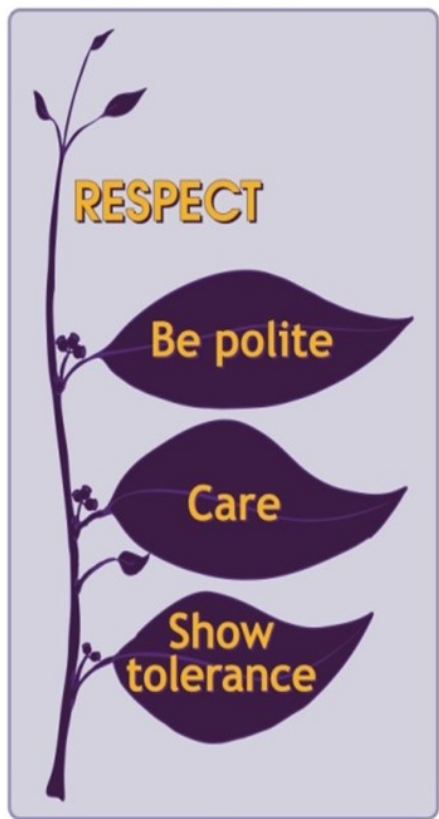

Library News—Arts Alive Film Festival

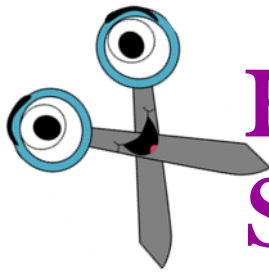

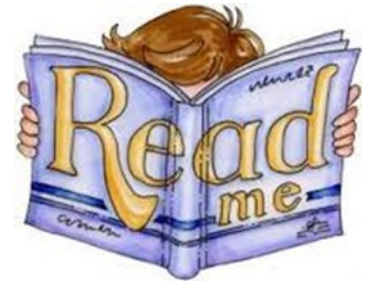

No Parking

No Stopping

- Stopping is not permitted at any time.
- If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction only applies during the times shown.

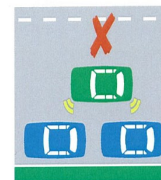
Bus Zones
