Berowra Public School will transition to the new NSW Public Schools' finance system and a new bank account on **14 June 2016.**

To ensure a smooth transition, there will be changes to the way we accept payments from parents and carers.

- EFTPOS payments: We will not be able to accept EFTPOS payments between 6 June 2016 and 15 June 2016. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding EFTPOS payments before 6 June. From 15 June 2016, EFTPOS payments will be accepted as before.
- Cash and cheque payments: Between 8 June 2016 and 15 June 2016, we will also not be able to accept payments by cash or cheque as we prepare to close our current bank account and transition to the new one. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding cash or cheque payments before 8 June 2016. From 15 June 2016, cash and cheque payments will be accepted as before.
- 2. Online payments: As of 7 June 2016, payments to our current online payment facility will cease. From 14 June 2016, we will begin to accept online payments using the Department of Education's Parent Online Payment (POP) system. A button to access this new online payment system titled '\$ Make a Payment' will be visible on the utility bar on the front page of our school's website at www.berowra-p.schools.nsw.edu.au. By selecting this link, parents and carers will be taken to a secure Westpac QuickWeb payment page from which they can make online payments.

Please note: As a Westpac-hosted solution cardholder all account details will be held securely helping to protect the school and its customers from fraudulent transactions as well as assisting in meeting the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCIDSS) compliance requirements.

CANTEEN—Volunteers are always welcome at the canteen. If you would like to help out, please see Heather on a Wednesday, Thursday or Friday.



MONEY COLLECTION DAYS

Please note that money collection days at Berowra Public School are **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays only.**

For security of payments it would be appreciated if money <u>only</u> be sent to school on these days in a signed payment envelope.

We have only two days a week allocated to receipt money so please remind your child to give it <u>to their</u> <u>teacher in the morning</u> as receipting and banking are completed during the day.

Correct money is appreciated as the office is unable to hold change.

Please do not hand payments in after school. Handing money into the office may result in confusion for the teacher and your child's name not being marked off as paid for sport, excursions and activities.

Any payments for the choir, drama, interschool sport or extra curricular activities as well as P&C or Support Group fundraisers and the canteen special lunch days can also be handed to the class teacher, but please include these in separate envelopes and with separate payment.

Don't forget that you can also pay online. However, signed permission envelopes are still required to go to the teacher for excursion. Just mark on it that you paid online.

SCHOLASTIC BOOK CLUB ORDERS

Please note that parents have the option, if they prefer to do so, of directly ordering and paying for their book club orders online, rather than submitting paper order forms and cash/cheque/credit card slips to the school office. For how to do this, please see ad opposite. If parents do order and pay online, their order will be sent to the school along with the main school book club order for delivery to their child's classroom. This means that the benefit is convenience of paying (and perhaps hiding an order from your child more easily than previously), rather than any speedier delivery.

Please be aware when ordering and paying online that **if you want your order to be SECRET** and not to be sent to your child's classroom, **you must let the book club coordinators, Natasha Steele and Tammy Allen, know this and give them some way of contacting you when the order arrives, preferably mobile number,** or the order will be sent to your child in their classroom. Natasha and Tammy can be contacted directly if you know either of them, or alternatively via a note in the book club letterbox in the school office. Any such notes must be dropped in the book club letterbox by the cut off date for returning order forms for the issue, or they may not be seen as the book club letterbox is only checked at this time.

The old method of ordering by returning paper order forms to the book club letterbox in the school office and paying by cash or cheque is still available. If you want your order to be SECRET, please clearly write 'SECRET' beside your phone number on the order form. Again, please be sure your order is returned by the cut off date for the issue. 
