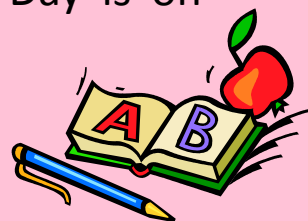
ENROL NOW FOR KINDERGARTEN 2017

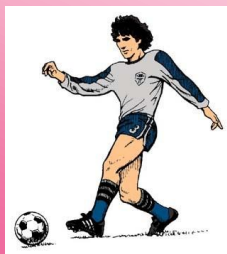

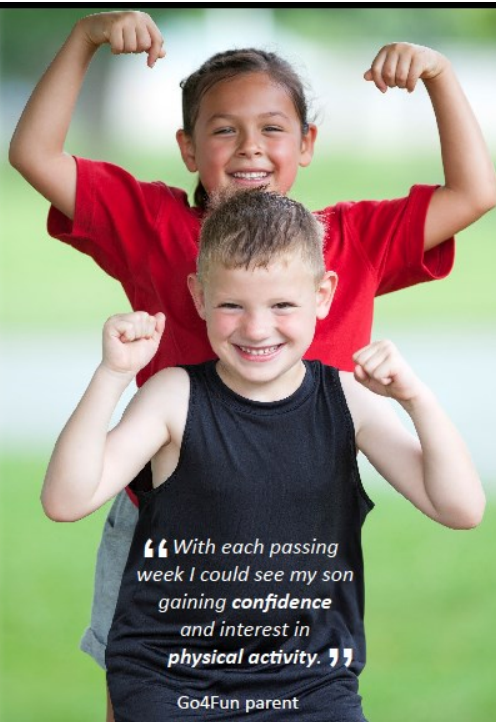
