School Uniform

I am very impressed to see nearly every child, nearly every day, in complete school uniform.

Please remember – leggings are not part of the school uniform or sports uniform and I would ask that they not be worn to school. Also short shorts are not part of the sports uniform for either boys or girls.

School Uniform Survey and Results

Many thanks to all parents, teachers and students who filled in the uniform survey - we had over 300 responses in total.

The majority of responses are in favour of the new 'optional' uniform. I have met with our 'uniform review committee' which consists of myself, some students, a P&C rep, a uniform shop rep and an AEGC rep to look at the results.

From these results and discussions at the last P&C meeting it has been decided that the new uniform will not be available for the rest of the school until 2018 - time is needed to clarify parts of the uniform and ensure that we will have enough stock.

This changeover in the school uniform will take 3-5 years – please do not panic and buy the new uniform if the current uniform is still in good condition.


What has been proposed is that from the start of Term 3, the uniform shop will be selling all gold shirts, girls winter tunics and summer dresses at 50% off the retail price.

Does your child require medication during the school day?

If your child needs to take any prescribed medication during school time, the office can administer it for you.

The medication <u>must</u> be handed into the office in the morning together with a completed 'Medication Request Form'. This form can be located on our website under 'Our School' tab then 'Missed a Note?' or completed at the office.

Only prescribed medication in original packaging can be accepted or over the counter medication with a doctor's note.

Please <u>do not give medication to children to self administer</u> during the day for their safety and the safety of other children.

The only exception is Ventolin for asthma.
