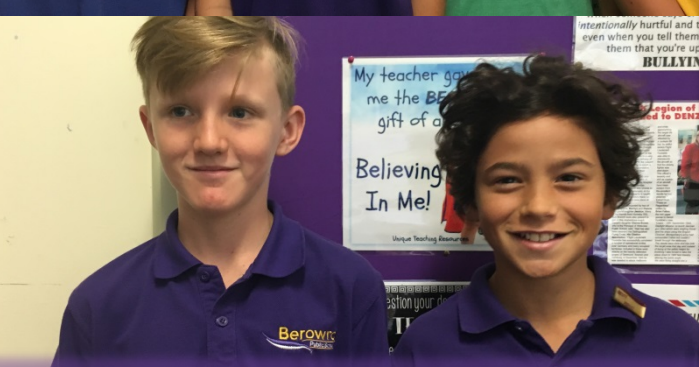

## Classroom Resources

The provision of quality education relies, not only on the quality of the teaching staff, but also on the quality of the resources, which we use to educate the children. We are fortunate to have an enthusiastic, talented and committed office and teaching staff at Berowra and, while they are keen to use the best resources available, they are well aware of the current economic climate and the hardships many families are experiencing.

To offset costs to families we have limited textbooks and are using duplicated copyright-free material, stencils, interactive whiteboard lessons and overheads prepared by the teachers instead. Added to the expense of the paper usage we must also carefully maintain the machines we use and buy the necessary inks and toners used in them. In addition to this we also ask for support in supplementing the schools budget to provide the upkeep and replacement of resources in the respective KLAs. Our classroom resources invoices were sent out earlier this term and we thank the parents who have already paid.

## Religious Education Policy

There has been some confusion about our Special Religion Education (known as Scripture). Children are placed into these classes (Anglican, Catholic, Islam, Jewish, Non-scripture or Ethics) from their enrolment form. Children are not able to move from their selection without a letter from the parent. At all times, we are bound by how many 'volunteer' teachers we have for each denomination. Unfortunately, Ethics Teachers seem to be hard to find. If a child is in a Religious Group (Anglican, Catholic, etc) and they wish to move to Ethics – parents need to send a letter stating they want their child to be placed in a non-scripture group. From this group they may then request that their child move to Ethics – if there is a vacant spot. No child will be moved mid-term.

I have included part of the Special Education In Ethics Policy from the department.....

*"Enrolment in special education in ethics Parents/caregivers **may only enrol their children in special education in ethics if the child has been exempted from special religious education.** Where a parent/caregiver requests special education in ethics and it is not currently available in the school, the school will provide the parent/caregiver with the names and contact details of approved providers of special education in ethics. It is the responsibility of the parent/caregiver to follow up with a provider. Students are to continue in the same arrangement each year, unless a parent/caregiver has requested a change."*

## Premier's Reading Challenge 2018

This Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely. The Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) is available for all NSW students in Kindergarten to Year 9, in government, independent, Catholic and home schools. The 2018 Challenge kicks off **Monday 5 March** and closes **Friday 31 August** (midnight) for **students**.

Most teachers have sent information home to all parents on how to log on and join this fantastic reading adventure.

## Mathletics...

As you know our students are encouraged to use Mathletics and Reading Eggs. These programmes will be accessed again this year during class time, and we encourage our students to use these programmes at home. All our students have usernames and passwords. If your child is unsure of theirs then please see their class teacher.

Many of our students receive Mathletics awards each week, reaching a Bronze, Silver or Gold level. From time



to time our students are recorded in the Athletics Hall of Fame.

I do enjoy seeing children with their Athletics certificates each week. To see so many children enjoy learning and education is always a highlight of my day.

Please remember – **FOUR** Athletic certificates or a Gold Athletic certificate equals a 'lucky dip' from my office. I have changed the number of certificates to be in line with our merit certificate process. Children need to come outside classroom time ie before or after school, morning tea or lunch time.

The Hall of Fame appears on the Athletics home page at [www.mathletics.com.au](http://www.mathletics.com.au). This is updated by the minute with only current and previous day's students appearing.

**Jake Da S and Julian C** – selected into the Hornsby/Kuring-gai combined football (soccer) team to play in the Sydney North Gala Day and Selections.



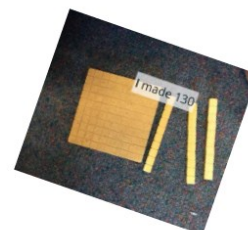
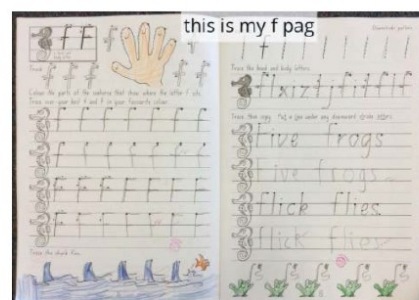
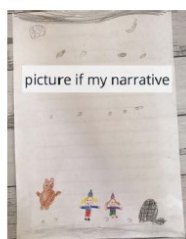
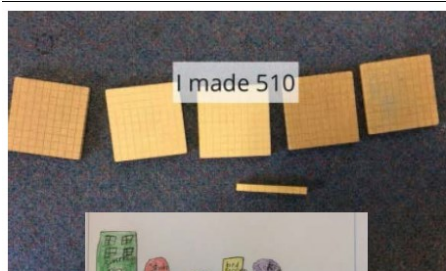
