
Question 1: What are 3 words to describe BPS?

2021 Changes to School Development Days in 2021.

Commencing at the start of 2021, the changes include:

- an increase from one to two SDDs at the commencement of Term 1
- a decrease from two to one SDDs at the end of Term 4.

The School Development Days are scheduled for the following dates:

27 and 28 January, students return 29 January 2021.

The two SDDs at the start of Term 1 are mandated and cannot be rescheduled. Principals may continue to vary SDDs that fall at the beginning of Terms 2 and 3, and at the end of Term 4.

There will be no changes to:

- the total number of SDDs remaining at five days
- the length of the school year for staff or students (students will start and finish the school year one day later)
- SDDs occurring at the commencement of Terms 2 and 3.

Transition

Current students in Kindy to Year 5 participated in a transition session on Tuesday 8 December where they moved classrooms for a session and worked with different teachers in preparation for 2021 class changes. Thanks Mr Griffin and Mrs Tonkes who organised the logistics of the transition sessions. Information from the transition will be used to inform and support students' successful transitions when we return to school in 2021.

Day 1 Organisation for returning students in 2021

Students retuning in Years 1 to Year 6 will start back on Friday 29 January 2021. Students will be placed with their 2020 class group for the day. This will allow them the opportunity to reconnect with their peers and hopefully reduce some anxiety around moving to a new class with a new teacher.

This will also allow a little extra transition time for our students and time for staff to finalise enrolment numbers and class allocations.

Students will bring their bags and meet under the COLA after the 9:20am bell. All students will be walked to the gates by the teachers for collection/dismissal as we have done during 2020. Stage 1 Main Gate near BOOSH, Stage 2 Bottom gate near the car park & Stage 3 the Hall Gate.

Our Kindy 2021 students will be attending at their scheduled time on either Friday 29 January – Tuesday 2 February to complete their Best Start Assessment.

All of our 2021 Kindy students start on Wednesday 3 February.

New Kindy Parents are to bring their children to the Hall COLA and we will have helpers to take them to their new classrooms, just like we did for Kindy Orientation Days.

Term 1 2021 DoE DRAFT planning guidelines

Please note the summary below:

Parents and carers can enter the school to:

- Drop off and pick up students
- Walk students to and from classes
- Purchase or pick up uniforms from the uniform shop
- Meet with school staff with an appointment
- Watch students participate in outdoor events and activities
- Attend school for orientation and educational meetings with school staff.

Gatherings are limited to 30 people indoors or 50 people outdoors and must have a COVID-19 Safety Plan in place.

P&C or other community outdoor social events, functions and fetes can proceed. These are limited to 50 people outdoors including students, staff and parents.

Principals may need to restrict, limit or prohibit activities if deemed to be contrary to the advice of the day.

Parents and carers are encouraged to download the NSW School Updates app to ensure that they are notified when schools are closed due to a crisis.

School Security

As you are aware vandalism has been an ongoing issue at our school site this year especially over the weekends. This is causing damage to our school property and is also a health and safety concern for our students, staff and visitors. If you notice or see any persons trespassing and acting suspiciously on the school grounds please contact Hornsby Police on 9476 9799 or the Police Assistance Line on 131444.

The security fence will remain around the equipment after school hours and during the school holidays, however BOOSH will have access to the equipment during vacation care times.

BOOSH Vacation Care

BPS is extremely lucky to have our amazing BOOSH offering Vacation Care during the school holidays. Community access will be restricted to the school site during Vacation Care dates to ensure the safety of the children and staff attending BOOSH.


