Teacher Learning

Berowra Public School proudly hosted our Instructional Rounds Network on Wednesday and Thursday of Week 9. Mrs Boon, Mrs Mitchell, Ms Cabral, Mrs Beckedahl and Ms Wallace who make up our Instructional Rounds Team participated in professional learning over the 2 days with teachers and principals from Oakhill Drive Public School, John Purchase Public School and Thornleigh West Public School. Our brave teachers invited the instructional round network into their rooms to conduct observations. The information gathered from the rounds was used to make recommendations for whole school future improvements in teaching and learning.

External Validation

BPS is currently engaged in the External Validation (EV) process which occurs in schools every 5 years. Teachers have worked hard to collect, annotate and analyse evidence to reflect areas of the School Excellence Framework (SEF). We have collaboratively rated our performance against each of the themes in the SEF and have decided on the where to next to drive our school planning. Our evidence was shared at the last P&C meeting and has been submitted for review by a panel. During Week 1 of Term 3 members of our Executive Team and our School Improvement Plan (SIP) Team will meet with the panel to discuss our evidence sets and ratings. Well done to our teachers who have worked hard on EV and especially to Mr Parkinson, Miss Simmons, Ms Cabral, Mrs Mitchell, Mrs Layson, Mr Pritchard, Mrs Beckedahl and Mrs Boon who collaboratively created a very comprehensive document which clearly tells our whole school's learning journey.

Parent Communication

We have updated our BPS Parent Communication Procedures and our BPS Visitor Procedures to include feedback from the P&C and community. These procedures are available on our school website.

The WHS requirements for volunteers has been updated. Please note the following:

Parent volunteers are required to show photo identification and complete a Declaration for Volunteers and Non Child related Contractors. This process can often take 24 hours.

Specified volunteers (Volunteers over the age of 18 who are not parents of close relatives of a child attending the school) must have a current working with children check (WWCC) paid or unpaid, must show photo identification and complete a Declaration for Child Related Work: Specified Volunteers and Contractors. These volunteers must be screened as a Volunteer/Contractor by the office **BEFORE** coming onsite. This process can often take longer than 24 hours and is currently longer than 2 weeks.

Please ensure you see the office for any assistance with this process.

School Bytes, our school email system is set up to send emails to the parent listed as the 1st contact on student enrolment forms. If you would like to add a second parent/carers contact to receive emails please email your request to the school email address.

Additionally if you change your email address or are not receiving emails please ensure you notify the school so we can check and update your details.

Risk Management Plans

If your child has sustained a serious injury and requires accommodations or adjustments to be put in place please phone the school office to make an appointment with me. We create Risk Management Plans to prevent any further injury and so that all staff are aware of any necessary changes that are put in place.

2022 Enrolments – Please enrol your child now for 2022 using online enrolmentsA child is entitled to enrol at the local school that the student is eligible to attend if his or her home is within that school's intake area.

Currently our school has an enrolment of 374 students. We sit 50 above our enrolment cap of 324 students. An out of area application for BPS can still be made, however, it is submitted to a panel who following the criteria to decide whether the application is accepted.

Attendance

Students should be at school unless:

- they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe.
- they are currently unwell.
- In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms.
- NSW Health has requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.
- Students and staff with flu-like symptoms will need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school.

When your child is absent from school, don't forget to send in a note on their return to school to explain their absence. This note should explain the reason for the child's absence, the date(s) of the absence and should be signed and dated by a parent or guardian.

Alternatively you can call the school office or send an email to the school's email address with the teacher's name in the subject bar and it will be forwarded to the appropriate staff member.
