It was wonderful to see our 39 parent and grandparent spectators supporting the children.






Student Safety

The school has been made aware of an alleged approach to a student near a central coast school on Friday night. We would appreciate your support in speaking to your children about Safe People/Safe Places, as we will be doing at school:

- Make sure your parents or another adult you know is aware of where you are at all times.
- Always walk straight home or to the required destination. Walk near busier roads and streets, or use paths where there are a lot of other people.
- Know where safe places are – a shop, service station, police station, library or school. If you are frightened, you should go to one of these places and ask them to call the police.
- Learn about safe adults you can look for and talk to if you need help – police officers, teachers at school, adults you know and trust.
- Don't talk to people you don't know and never get into a car with someone you don't know. If a car stops on the side of the road and you don't know the person inside, do not stop.
- If you are scared and can use a phone, call Triple Zero (000) and tell them you are scared.
- If someone tries to grab you, yell out, 'Go away, I don't know you!' This lets other people know you have been approached by someone you don't know.

Risk Management Plans

If your child has sustained a serious injury and requires accommodations or adjustments to be put in place please phone the school office to make an appointment with me. We create Risk Management Plans to prevent any further injury and so that all staff are aware of any necessary changes that are put in place.

Stage Zoom Parent Information Sessions Week 5

Our Stage Zoom Parent teacher Information Sessions were held in Week 5 and Stage 2 in Week 6. It was a great opportunity for parents to find out about what's happening in each stage and ask any questions. We had 39 participants in the ES1 Session, 49 participants in the Stage 1 session, 29 participants in the Stage 2 session and 40 participants in the Stage 3 session.

Teacher are working on compiling the Questions and Answers from each session and these will be sent to all parents as soon as they are finalised.

2022 Enrolments

A child is entitled to enrol at the local school that the student is eligible to attend if his or her home is within that school's intake area.

Currently our school has an enrolment of 373 students. We sit 73 above our enrolment cap of 300 students. An out of area application for BPS can still be made, however, it is submitted to a panel who following the criteria to decide whether the application is accepted.

Attendance

Students should be at school unless:

- they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe.
- they are currently unwell.
- In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms.
- NSW Health has requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.
- Students and staff with flu-like symptoms will need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school.

When your child is absent from school, don't forget to send in a note on their return to school to explain their absence.

This note should explain the reason for the child's absence, the date(s) of the absence and should be signed and dated by a parent or guardian.



Mufti Day:




Our first mufti day is coming up on **Wednesday 10th March**. Children are asked to bring in a gold coin donation which will donation to go towards P&C initiatives.

Please see below for the slight change in the Uniform Shop procedure:
