Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to Term 3. We have a busy term planned with learning, extracurricular activities, and opportunities for our community to be welcomed into the school to celebrate and share our learning.

We thank the parents, students, and teachers for their participation in parent/teacher interviews and/or Learning Conversations. We also thank the parents who took the time to provide feedback about Learning Conversations. We use this feedback to adjust our current organisation and practice so that we are constantly improving what we are doing. BPS had an 83% participation rate in parent/teacher

interviews and/or Learning Conversations, with a total of 286 parent/teacher interviews and Learning Conversations scheduled.

As you may be aware there has been a delay in our Oval Rejuvenation project due to the rain. We were hoping our oval would be finished by Open Day in Week 3, however at this stage it is very unlikely as the grounds are still extremely wet. We will keep you updated on the progress.




The metro renewal project which involves the refurbishment of D block (Administration and the old Kindy classrooms) and half of A block (staffroom and office areas) has been further delayed. It is now expected that the project will not start until mid-September.

Based on parent feedback and due to the delayed schedule parents and carers will be allowed on site to collect their children in the afternoon. We request that parents enter the grounds **after 3:10pm** and wait at the silver seats on the synthetic turf. Please make sure you speak to your children about where you are collecting them to avoid any unnecessary confusion. Kindergarten pick-up procedures will remain the same and their teachers will bring the children to the Hall Cola. Please note that we may need to revert back to previous pick-up arrangements if Covid guidelines change or due to WHS when the asset works are taking place.

Last week it was wonderful to welcome our Director Ros McCallan-Jamieson and the Executive Director Tim McCallum to the school for lunch and a visit. They were able to visit some of our classes and see the many changes in our school environment including our fabulous Library makeover.

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During Semester 2 at BPS we are excited to be diving into digital technologies in our STEM lessons. STEM so far this year has been a great opportunity for students to learn 21st Century skills with a focus on the 4C's; Collaboration, Critical Thinking, Creativity and Communication. Students have enjoyed being hands on and creative whilst learning about the world around them. This semester we have hired a 3D printer which will be used for Stages 2 and 3 as they learn how to build in the digital space and watch it come to life in the printing phase. Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 will be exploring the foundational skills of coding and programming using our Bee Bots. We can't wait to see what the students will come up with in these lessons.




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Covid Updates

Staff and students who are close contacts and have no symptoms to continue to attend school if they follow guidelines agreed with NSW Health.

Before considering whether to return to school or work, please use the decision tree that follows to assist with whether it is appropriate.



Note that staff and students who have had confirmed COVID-19 in the last 4 weeks, do not have to comply with these guidelines if they become a household or close contact and are not required to self-isolate or test unless they develop new COVID-19 symptoms.

- Please notify the school if your child is intending to return under this provision. Schools will need to maintain this record on their local management systems
- Staff and students should conduct a daily rapid antigen test (RAT) and return a negative result each morning before attending school for 5 school days.
- Primary school students are recommended to wear a mask indoors (except when eating or exercising).
- No student or staff member identified as a close contact will be permitted to participate in overnight excursions, including school camps.
- Any visitor to a school site who is a close contact is required to advise the school
 that they are a close contact before they come on site. These visitors should
 conduct a daily RAT and return a negative result before attending. They must
 also wear a mask indoors at all times. Schools should consider if the visit can be
 conducted virtually.

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Notifications for absentees

Thank you to the P&C who has suggested the use of a text-based system for notifying parents their child is absent. We have investigated this and are able to use the Sentral system to do this. Once the office staff is trained we will let you know when we will start trialling the new system. We thank you for your patience while we get this organised.

Early Departures

If your child needs to be collected to leave early, please try to collect them before or after our break times to avoid any unnecessary delays in collection. Our recess time is 11:20-11:45am and our lunch time is 1:30-2:20pm.

Drop-offs and pick-ups

The drop off of students will continue from Hillcrest Road. To limit contact please ensure you don't linger at drop off or pick up. Teacher supervision in the playground starts at 8:50am, so please ensure students walking to school by themselves are arriving after 8:50am.

Please be reminded that parents should not enter school grounds to drop off students before school.

All parents need to attend the school office during school hours to collect early leavers or deliver late arrivals.

Students catching a bus or riding a bike will exit from the Hall gate.

Parent Communication

BPS Parent Communication Procedures and our BPS Visitor Procedures are available on our school website.

We encourage parents to engage in their child's learning by leaving a like or a comment on their Seesaw work. If you have questions, enquiries, or comments for teachers please email or phone the school and the teacher will get back to you as soon as possible.

School Bytes, our school email system is set up to send emails to the parent listed as the 1st contact on student enrolment forms. If you would like to add a second parent/carers contact to receive emails please email your request to the school email address.

Additionally, if you change your email address or are not receiving emails, please ensure you notify the school so we can check and update your details.

Intensive cleaning will continue to take place daily and schools are being provided with additional hygiene supplies.

Risk Management Plans

If your child has sustained a serious injury and requires accommodations or adjustments to be put in place please phone the school office to make an appointment with me. We create Risk Management Plans to prevent any further injury and so that all staff are aware of any necessary changes that are put in place.

Enrolments – Please enrol your child now using online enrolments

A child is entitled to enrol at the local school that the student is eligible to attend if his or her home is within that school's intake area.

Currently our school has an enrolment of 346 students. We sit 22 above our enrolment cap of 324 students. An out of area application for BPS can still be made, however, it is submitted to a panel who follow criteria to decide whether the application is accepted.

Learning From Home

Berowra PS is utilising the Department of Education's Learning from Home packages to support students who are at home in isolation due to COVID-19. These resources are available without a school log in - students select their grade level and can be guided through the tasks with a series of videos and explanations. There are now 2 suites of home learning packages and students can start in either. Each suite gives a suggested starting point.

Work can be completed offline and returned to the class teacher when your child returns, or via a digital tool such as Google Docs or Slides.

Students may also access their individual class Google Classroom (Yrs 3-6) or Seesaw and complete any work or activities that may have been posted for the class or upload any tasks they have completed from the home learning platform.

Students may also complete Mathletics, Reading Eggs or Decodable Readers Australia Online as appropriate. Other possible learning activities include:

- Reading aloud to practice fluent and expressive reading
- Reading privately
- Writing in a journal or free writing book stories, reviews of books or movies etc
- Playing card or dice games
- Research a topic of personal interest and create a presentation to share what was learned

Of course, if your child is feeling unwell, there is no expectation that they complete work at home.

If you do not have adequate access to devices, please contact the school to make arrangements for a loan device. Please email your class teacher via the office if you have any issues with log in details for any of the mentioned platforms.

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Attendance

Teachers are still recording attendance. If your child is sick please let the school know by either email or phone so that we can update our rolls accordingly and if they are isolating we are able to provide learning from home.

Students who are learning from home are recorded as Flexible 'F' on the roll. This will not negatively affect their attendance. Teachers will be checking if students have submitted work.

Currently, there are three COVID-19 categories of attendance that will affect the codes used for roll marking.

Face to face learning at school

Learning from home - teacher assisted (cohorts or schools) Learning from home - self-paced learning (individuals)

Description

Schools are open for face-to-face learning and all students are expected to attend school on-site.

Roll marked as 'F': Where a class, year group or whole school is instructed to learn from home and the student is participating in the learning.

Roll marked as 'F': Where an individual student is required to learn from home due to a medical reason or a Public Health Order and the student is participating in learning.

For students who are unwell there is no expectation that learning from home be comple

Road Safety

Due to lack of casuals at Transport for NSW, BPS may not have a crossing supervisor allocated daily until Miriam's position is filled. Please remind your children of the road safety messages below.

We are excited to share more information regarding our school oval upgrade!

As you are aware, BPS P&C were successful with securing a grant for \$100,000 through the Community Building Partnership Program with the support of local sporting clubs. This injection of funds has allowed us to get this project off the ground and make it a reality. The new synthetic surface will provide more space and opportunities for students to play and learn safely all year round. The new space will be 50m x 25m with a running track around the outside as well as multiple field markings to allow for different configurations. The work will begin in July school holidays and will take approximately 4 weeks (weather dependent). The oval will be a welcomed addition to our wonderful school and we look forward to seeing the end product.
