The teachers in the network engaged in professional learning around the 'problem of practice,' conducted classroom observations, collated data from the observations to create findings and then provided detailed suggestions on where to next for our school in terms of professional learning for teachers to improve student outcomes.

Our problem of practice for 2023 was:

- Are our maths lessons worthwhile?
- Are teachers using effective questions to deepen student thinking and formatively assess?
- Are we providing opportunities for students to: questions, reason, communicate and share their mathematical understanding?

We are excited to find out what the observational data will tell us about teaching and learning in our classrooms.
