Learning on Country

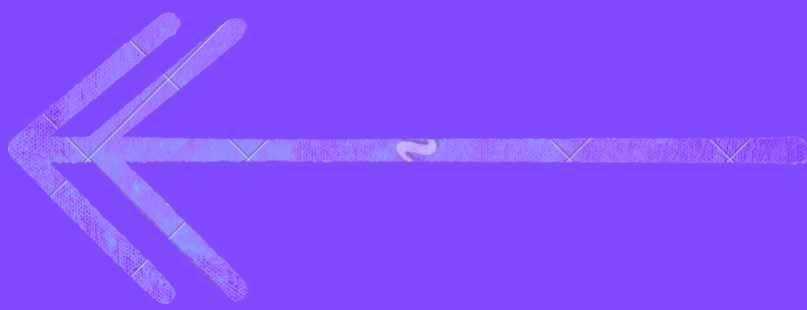
