Planning for 2025

We're currently planning our 2025 classes and staffing, a complex process where your input is invaluable. If you're moving over the holidays, switching schools, or planning an extended holiday that may affect your child's return on the first day of Term 1, please let us know as soon as possible. Our funding depends on student numbers, and each student counts as we decide between 10 or 11 classes. If you know anyone moving into the area, please encourage them to contact the school. New changes to the enrolment policy starting in Term 1, 2025, offer more flexibility, especially for out-of-area families with siblings already enrolled. 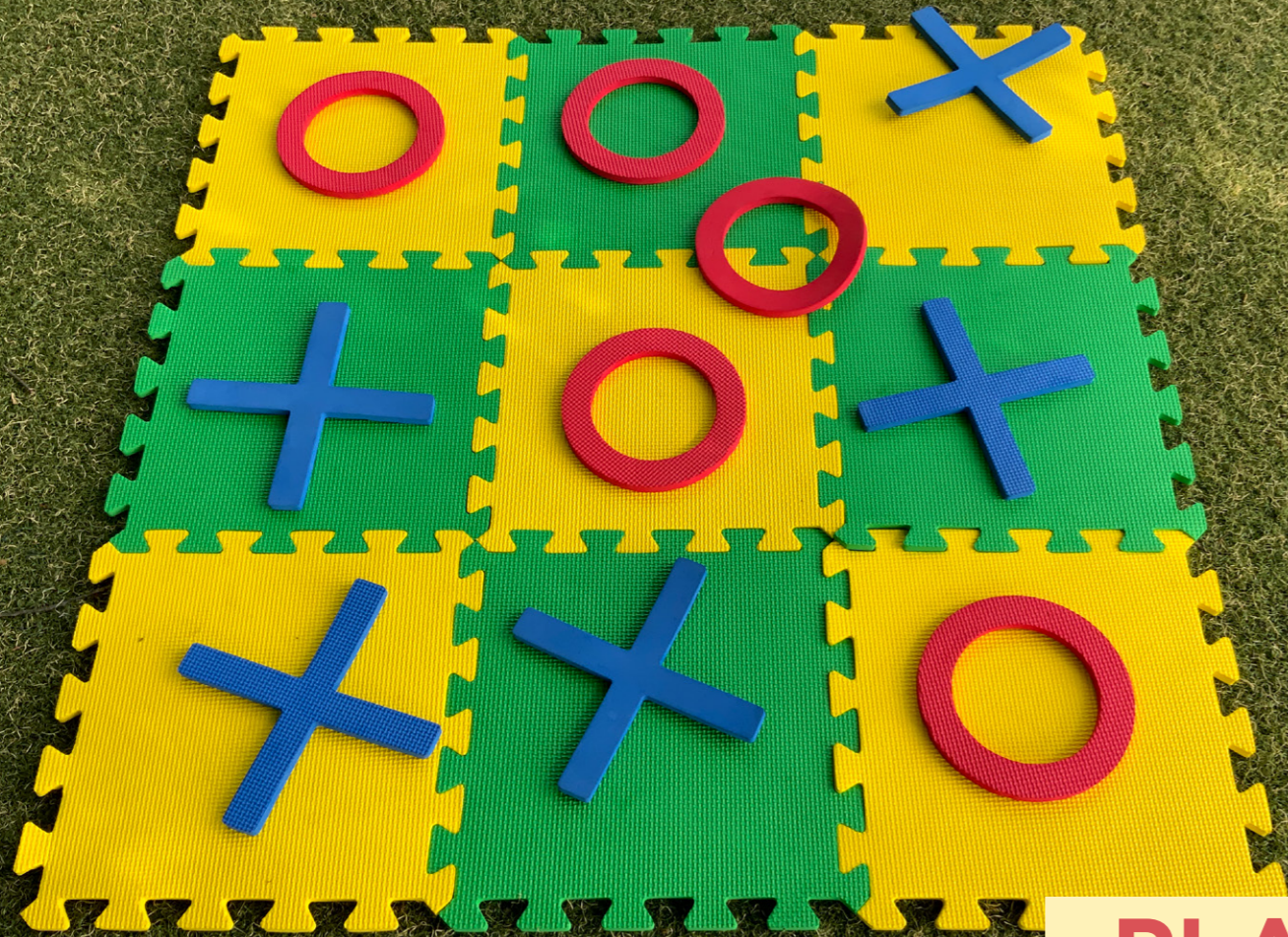


GRANDPARENTS AND FRIENDS DAY

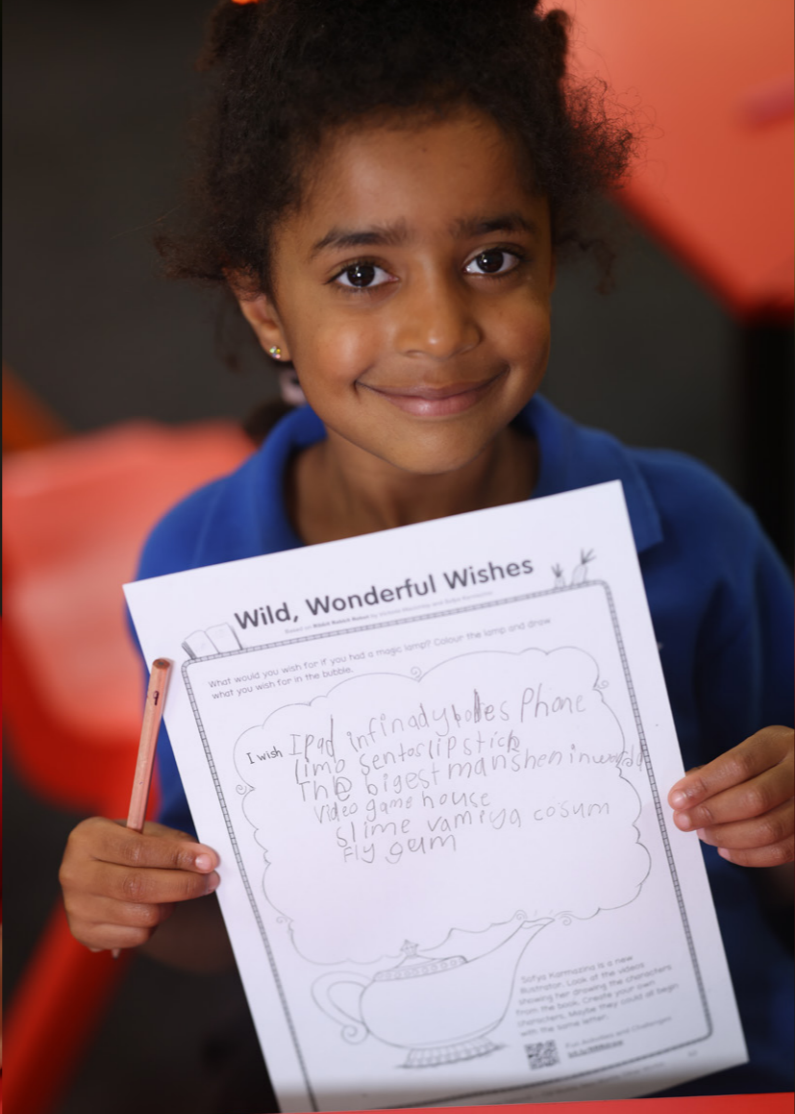
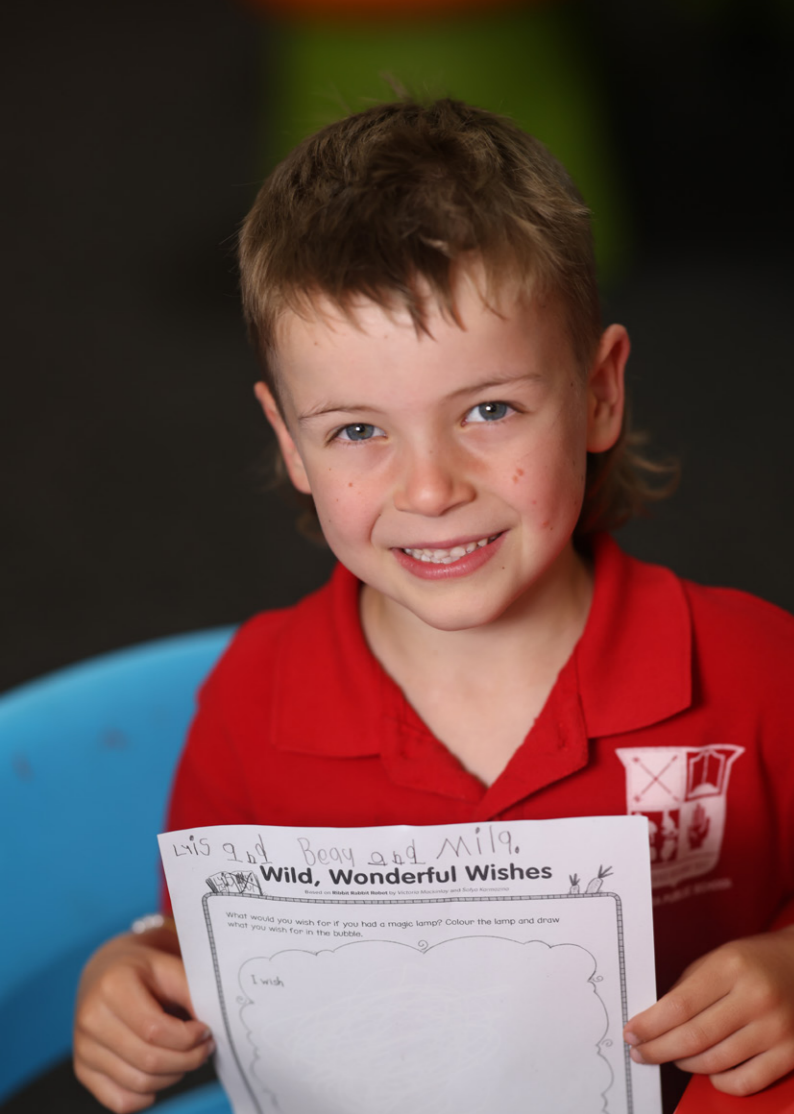




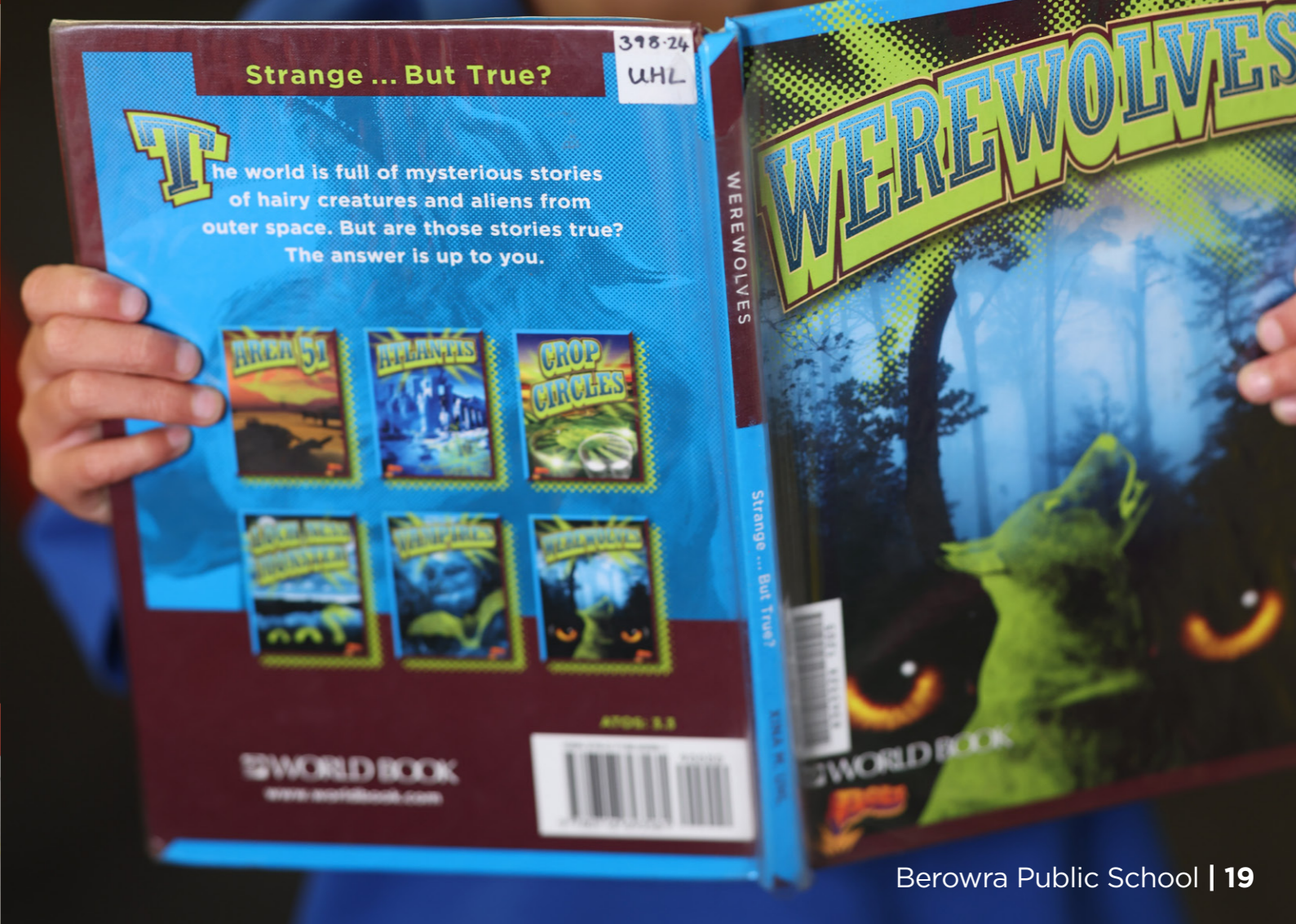

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY: THE LEARNING GUMTREE

Created by Aboriginal artist Courtney Garstang in consultation with Berowra Public School's Aboriginal students, this artwork honors the sacred landscape on which we learn, celebrating its natural beauty and encouraging students to care for the land as our traditional custodians have done for countless generations.

At the centre stands a learning gumtree, with roots symbolising strong community and family foundations, while the branches represent each of the seven grades students journey through in primary school. Stars depict the students, shining as they reach their full potential.

The honey ant nest symbolises a united community working toward shared goals, and the spirit feet remind us that past custodians walk with us still. Look closely to find our local totems—the stingray, wallaby, and possum.

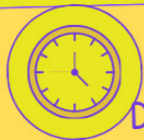

This fortnight's Smiling Mind focus is Positive Communication

At Home Activities

K-2

20 Second Mindful Hug Challenge

Sometimes communication can be non-verbal, which means that you don't need words to communicate. For this task, hug someone in your family tonight for a full 20 seconds. Afterwards, discuss with that person how this made you feel. Remember to mindfully listen and take turns speaking.

Stage 2

Mindful Listening Drawing

Sometimes communication can be non-verbal, which means that our body language also plays a big part in communicating. For this activity, draw what it looks like when someone is mindfully listening and when someone is not mindfully listening. For example someone who is mindfully listening might have good eye contact and someone who is not mindfully listening might be interrupting or not facing the person who is speaking. This week, think about how your body language is showing the person who is speaking that you are mindfully listening to them.

Stage 3

Mindful Conversation

Mindful communication is when you speak with intention and listen with focus and curiosity. Practise having a mindful conversation with someone in your family this week. Make sure that you are tuning in to what you are saying and listening carefully. Write about your experience afterwards: How did it feel? Was it difficult to remember to be mindful? What are some things to remind yourself of when trying to have a mindful conversation?

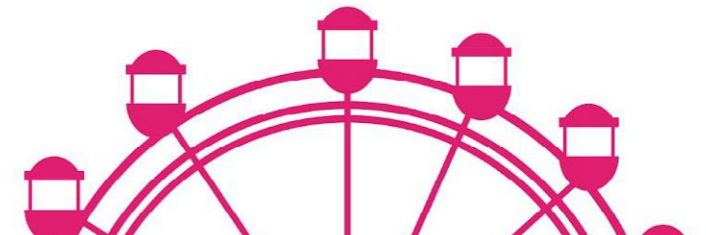
